\$ You'll need \$20.00 for the tour at Britannia Mines, so be sure to top up your wallet and not just your gas tank!

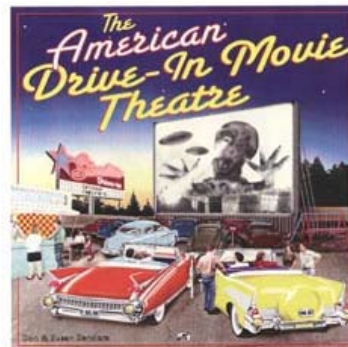
June 13: Twilight Theatre Drive-In *The Twilight Drive-in cruise is back!*
